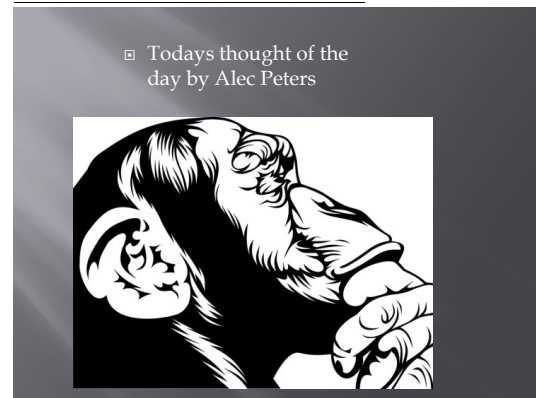

This is Anthony's second presentation to our club and the LEAP program has grown throughout South Africa presented his club banner from Newland South Africa to David. He has four Rotary Clubs in America helping grow this great student program in South Africa.

Whole child development, Academic, Social, Psychological, for 5 full years. Is the goal of the LEAP program?

They have grown from 73 students to over 983 this year. 50% of their students pass the university level test. They offer full scholarships to the high school program with no fees, extended school days, community up liftment, Engage raise the student's expectations.

There are now six LEAP schools in South Africa and 50 of their students have now graduated university and one has attained their M.A. degree.
